As you may know, the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners has directed MSD to provide information that will help the Board evaluate the costs of extending the sewer system and servicing the residents and business currently on private home sewage treatment systems. The Village of Terrace Park has interest in joining the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD). The Village's interest is to gain access to central sewer service, which would allow elimination of approximately 830 existing how sewage treatment systems. Professional planning services are required to identify and evaluate various alternatives to provide sewer service to Terrace Park.

MSD has procured professional services firm, RA Consultants, and their sub-consultants, Jacobs and Browne Engineering & Construction, to provide professional engineering and related services for planning of the Terrace Park Sewer Service Study. The consultant team plans to perform site reconnaissance in the Village during April and May 2019 to inform the preparation of a planning report. You and Village residents may see representatives of the consultant team in the Village performing reconnaissance. The consultant's personnel will generally remain within the public right-of-way.

A final planning report will be prepared and provided to the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners so the Board may assess the viability of accepting the Village into MSD.
