**RESOLUTION 5-3, 2025**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE FINAL HAMILTON COUNTY 911 PLAN PURSUANT TO  
OHIO REVISED CODE CHAPTER 128 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio has enacted legislation under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 128 governing the establishment and operation of Enhanced 9-1-1 (E9-1-1) systems, and requires counties to develop and maintain a comprehensive countywide final plan for public safety answering point (PSAP) services; and

**WHEREAS**, Hamilton County has completed the development of its Final 911 Plan in accordance with the requirements of ORC §128.03 and ORC §128.06; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, formally approved the Final 911 Plan on April 10, 2025, following the procedures set forth in Chapter 128 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**WHEREAS**, this legislative body, having reviewed the Final 911 Plan and finding that the plan supports the continued enhancement of 911 service delivery within the County, desires to approve the plan as required under ORC §128.03 and related provisions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO that:**


**Section 1.** The Council hereby approves the Final Hamilton County 911 Plan, as adopted by the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners on April 10, 2025, and authorizes its submission to the appropriate county and state authorities as evidence of the jurisdiction's approval pursuant to ORC Chapter 128.

**Section 2.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Hamilton County 911 Planning Committee for inclusion in the record of jurisdictional approvals.


**Section 3.** The three separate readings required by law are hereby waived. This Resolution shall be acted upon as an emergency in order to approve the final 911 plan at the earliest possible date.

**Section 4.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the manner as heretofore determined by Council.



**WHEREAS**, the complement of full-time Police Officers for the Village of Terrace Park is in need of an additional Police Officer.



**Section 1.** Douglas M. Moening be appointed as a full-time Police Officer at the probationary annual rate of compensation of \$ 82,234.77.



**Section 3.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the manner heretofore determined by Council.


