WHEREAS, Village Council previously authorized a contract with Rumpke for waste and refuse collection; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke has offered to extend the contract through October 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest to the Village to enter into the proposed contract extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO that:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract extension with Rumpke for the collection of waste and refuse pursuant to the terms of the addendum attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein reference.

Section 2. That all other provisions of the existing contract shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. The three separate readings required by law are hereby waived. This Resolution shall be acted upon as an emergency in order to prevent an interruption in service of waste and refuse collection.

Section 4. The Village Clerk be, and she hereby is authorized and directed to publish this Resolution by posting a copy thereof in the five most public places in the Village as heretofore determined by Council.

PROVIDING REVISED CONSENT TO THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE A PROJECT RELATED TO US 50 AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS OR DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The following is a Resolution enacted by the Village of Terrace Park of Hamilton County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has determined the need for the described project:

Rehabilitate bridge HAM-50-2910 (US 50 over 2 railroads, Duck Creek, and Red Bank Rd, SFN 3103811) by removing and replacing the existing deck with a new composite, reinforced concrete deck; Replace the backwalls, expansion joints, and approach slabs per current standards; Upgrade bridge to meet current seismic requirements. Rehabilitate bridge HAM-50-2928 (US 50 over ramps to Red Bank Rd., SFN 3103870) by removing and replacing the existing deck with a new composite, reinforced concrete deck; Increase the vertical clearance to obtain a finished vertical clearance of 15.5 feet; Replace the backwalls, expansion joints, and approach slabs. Resurface the pavement in the Villages of Fairfax and Terrace Park—PID 110570

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Terrace Park of Hamilton County, Ohio. (LPA)

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project as detailed in the LPA-ODOT-Let Agreement entered into between the parties, if applicable.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the development and construction of the above described project and shall enter into a LPA Federal ODOT Let Project Agreement, if applicable, as well as any other agreements necessary to develop and construct the Project.

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV Authority to Sign

The LPA hereby authorizes its Village Administrator of said Village of Terrace Park to

(LPA-or its division, department or agency)

enter into and execute contracts with the Director of Transportation which are necessary to develop plans for and to complete the above-described project; and to execute contracts with ODOT pre-qualified consultants for the preliminary engineering phase of the Project.

Upon request of ODOT, the Village Administrator is also empowered to execute any appropriate documents to (Signature authority)

affect the assignment of all rights, title, and interests of the Village of Terrace Park to ODOT arising from any (LPA)

agreement with its consultant in order to allow ODOT to direct additional or corrective work, recover damages due to errors or omissions, and to exercise all other contractual rights and remedies afforded by law or equity.

SECTION V -- Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION VI - Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable State and Federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

The LPA agrees to inspect and maintain all raised pavement markers installed with this project inside their corporation limit. The LPA understands ODOT will not inspect or maintain these raised pavement markers after the completion of the project.

ORDINANCE 9-1, 2023

DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AND PROVIDING FOR CONTROLLING THE BLIGHT AND DISEASE OF SHADE TREES WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND FOR PLANTING, MAINTAINING, TRIMMING AND REMOVING SHADE TREES IN AND ALONG THE STREETS OF TERRACE PARK WHICH INCLUDES ALL TERRITORY WITHIN AND COEXTENSIVE WITH ITS BOUNDARIES, FOR THE YEAR 2024, AUTHORIZING THE OFFICERS OF TERRACE PARK TO DO SUCH WORK FOR THE YEAR 2024, PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF AN ASSESSMENT UPON REAL PROPERTY IN TERRACE PARK FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE OF SUCH WORK

WHEREAS, it is immediately urgent and necessary that the work be authorized for the said shade tree program in said District for the year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Terrace Park has determined that it is beneficial to all property owners in the Village of Terrace Park to maintain, trim, remove and plant shade trees in and along the streets of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 727 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for such tree maintenance and planting and assessment levying therefore on an annual basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, STATE OF OHIO, that:

Section 1: It is hereby declared necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare to continue a shade tree program during the year 2024 within the public rights-of-way and streets of the Village of Terrace Park. This tree program is hereby designated for the Village of Terrace Park, which includes all territory within and coexistence with its boundaries for the year 2024;

Section 2. The plans, estimate of cost and schedules heretofore prepared and now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Village be and the same are hereby approved.

Section 3: The work of such shade tree program shall be done as herein set forth and through the proper officers of the Village of Terrace Park and the said officials be and are hereby authorized and directed to purchase required materials, to purchase or rent the necessary tools, machinery, and appliances, to employ the necessary labor to do such work all in accordance with the plans, estimates, and schedules, heretofore prepared, and now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Village for inspection of all persons interested. In addition to said authority and direction, the said officials can contract with other parties for all or any provisions of said plans, estimates and schedules required for the continuation of said tree program.

Section 4. The Village of Terrace Park shall pay two percent (2%) of the total cost and expense of said shade tree program for the year 2024, together with the estimate cost and expense of said

shade tree program allocable to intersections, and the balance of said total cost and expense of said tree program for the year 2024 representing \$0.70 per \$1,000.00 of 2024 taxable value of all property in Terrace Park, except property owned by the Federal Government, the State of Ohio, the Village of Terrace Park, the Terrace Park Charitable trust, and public utilities.

Section 5. Said assessments shall be paid in two installments and they shall be certified by the Treasurer of the Village and Clerk of Village to the Hamilton County, Ohio Auditor for collection at the same time and in the same manner as real property taxes due and payable in December 2023 and June 2024 are collected.

Section 6. Notice of the passage of the Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation and at the five most public places as hereto determined by Council.

Section 7. That portion of the cost and expense of said shade tree program not specifically assessed, shall be paid out of a fund provided to pay the Village's portion of the cost and expense of shade tree program.

Section 8. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance by posting a copy thereof in the five most public places in the Village as heretofore determined by Council.
