EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there currently exists a vacancy in the office of Council member; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32.06 of the Terrace Park Codified Ordinances, when the office of a member of the Legislative Authority becomes vacant, the vacancy shall be filled by election by the Legislative Authority for the unexpired term.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Terrace Park,

5 members elected thereto concurring:



Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to fill the vacancy at the earliest possible date.



WHEREAS, the complement of full-time Police Officers for the Village of Terrace Park is in need of an additional Police Officer.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF

**Section 1.** James Savage be appointed as a full-time Police Officer at the probationary annual rate of compensation of \$73,000.00.




