

MINUTES OF MEETING
October 8, 2019
VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK COUNCIL
HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO

Council met on Tuesday October 8, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. in the Terrace Park Community Building. Mayor Tepe led Council in the Pledge of Allegiance. Members of Council present were Mr. John Gaskey, Ms. Lauren Ingebritson, Ms. Judith Lehman, Mr. Jeff LeMay, Mr. Pax Lindell and Ms. Regina Sharp. In addition, Mayor Tom Tepe, Village Administrator Gerald Hayhow and Clerk of Council Christy Hampton were present. Solicitor Jeff Forbes, Chief Fiscal Officer Katie Lyons EMS Chief John Maggard and Fire Chief Steve Dronsfield were absent.

The Mayor asked if anyone had any corrections, additions or deletions to the September minutes. Council Member Gaskey motioned to approve Council Minutes from the September 17, 2019 Council meeting. Voice vote, all voted aye. Minutes approved.

RESIDENTS TO ADDRESS COUNCIL

The Mayor asked if there were any residents to address council. Seeing none, he moved on.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Tepe said there isn't much to report since it had only been 3 weeks since our last meeting. He did enjoy Music on the Green – a great time was had by all and everyone was well behaved. There is another one this Saturday, October 12- he encouraged everyone to come hungry, bring money and enjoy Chilipalooza and the Ukulele brothers (rain location is the TP Fire Station).

EMS CHIEF: Absent, but Regina Sharp said they are recruiting for the January EMS class, so if anyone has any suggested recruits, let Regina or John Maggard know and they will follow up.

POLICE CHIEF/VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: Hayhow wanted to remind everyone that leaf pickup will begin the week of October 14. They won't be out every day as they should be able to make one pass and get them all. At that time brush pickup will be suspended. Please make sure there is nothing in the leaf piles; we've spent about \$2000 on a new impeller/welding inside the leaf machine because when it picks up other objects, it destroys the impellers. Please make sure your piles contain leaves only. Also, leaf piles should be in your yard, not in the street (safety concern for cars and for kids playing in them) and not on parking pads (if they contain large rocks).

Gaskey, Ingebritson, Lehman, LeMay, Lindell and Sharp voted aye. LeMay then moved to adopt the resolution. Lindell seconded. Gaskey, Ingebritson, Lehman, LeMay, Lindell and Sharp voted aye. LeMay then moved to adopt the resolution as an emergency. Sharp seconded. Gaskey, Ingebritson, Lehman, LeMay, Lindell and Sharp voted aye. Resolution passed as an emergency
