A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2026 ANNUAL TAX BUDGET FOR
THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, the Village Council of the Village of Terrace Park is required to prepare and file an annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the required public hearing has been held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Terrace Park, Hamilton County, Ohio, 5 members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Village Council of the Village of Terrace Park approves and adopts the 2026 Tax Budget for the Village of Terrace Park as presented, the full text of which is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A."


Section 2. That a certified copy of the 2026 Tax Budget shall be filed with the County Budget Committee.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


Section 4. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the manner as heretofore determined by Council.

RESOLUTION 6-2, 2025

**REQUESTING THE HAMILTON COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE
CALCULATION OF REVENUE GENERATED BY THE REPLACEMENT AND
INCREASE OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK EXISTING 2.80 MILL
CURRENT OPERATING LEVY WITH A LEVY OF 5.75 MILLS**

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mills limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Terrace Park, Hamilton County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village currently levies a tax of 2.80 mills approved by the electors of the Village of Terrace Park for current operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that in order to continue to provide adequate governmental services for the Village that it is necessary to replace the existing 2.80 mill levy with an additional 2.95 mills constituting a replacement levy of 5.75 mills.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO that:**

Section 1. The Council of the Village of Terrace Park hereby determines that it is necessary to replace 2.80 mills of an existing levy and an increase of 2.95 mills, to constitute a current operating levy at a rate not to exceed 5.75 mills for each \$1.00 of taxable value, pursuant to section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, which amounts to \$0.575 for each \$100.00 of the county auditor's appraised value, for five (5) years.

Section 2. Said replacement levy shall be placed upon the tax list of 2025 for collection in 2026 if the majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. The replacement tax levy for general operating purposes shall be submitted to the electors of Terrace Park at a regular election to be held at the usual voting places within Terrace Park on November 4, 2025.


Section 4. The entire territory of the Village of Terrace Park exists only within Hamilton County, and the proposed tax shall be submitted to and levied upon the entire territory of the Village of Terrace Park.

Section 5. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to immediately certify to the County Auditor this Resolution requesting that the County Auditor certify to the Council

of the Village of Terrace Park the total tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount or revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid 5.75 mills.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be adopted as an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare within the community for the reason that it is necessary to continue to provide the necessary governmental services for the citizens of the Village of Terrace Park.



RESOLUTION 6-4, 2025

**CONSENT OF COUNCIL TO THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF

SECTION 2. Council hereby waives the three separate readings of this resolution and hereby advances it to the third and final reading.

SECTION 3. That the Village Clerk be, and she hereby is directed to publish this Resolution by posting a copy thereof as heretofore determined by Council.


