RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO MAKE TAX ADVANCES
DURING THE YEAR 2026 PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE, SECTION 321.34
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code allows a local taxing authority to request payment from the County Auditor of funds derived from taxes or other sources to the County treasurer, which may be held on account of a location subdivision.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Terrace Park, Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. The Auditor and the Treasurer of Hamilton County, in accordance with Ohio revised Code 321.34, be required to draw and pay to the Village of Terrace Park, upon the written request of the Chief Fiscal Officer, to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement of 2026 derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the account of the Village of Terrace Park, and lawfully applicable for purposes of the current fiscal year.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of the Village of Terrace Park be, and hereby is, directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Auditor of Hamilton County, Ohio.




**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE



SECTION 3. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the manner heretofore determined by Council.



RESOLUTION 2-4, 2026

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO RIVER FOUNDATION TO IDENTIFY, REMOVE AND MONITOR INVASIVE PLANT SPECIES LOCATED AT THE MIAMI GROVE NATURE PRESERVE AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000

WHEREAS, the Village of Terrace Park and the Ohio River Foundation have agreed on terms for the identification, removal, and monitoring of invasive species for approximately 4 to 6 acres at Miami Grove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, STATE OF OHIO, that


SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio River Foundation for the identification, removal, and monitoring of invasive species for approximately 4 to 6 acres at Miami Grove, substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to pay the Ohio River Foundation a sum not to exceed \$10,000 pursuant to the terms of said Agreement.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare in order to provide adequate insurance coverage for the Village.

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the manner heretofore determined by Council.


