RESOLUTION 3-1, 2026

**FIXING THE SALARIES AND RATINGS OF VILLAGE EMPLOYEES EFFECTIVE
MARCH 16, 2026**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK,
STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the salary of the Chief of Police of the Village of Terrace Park shall range from \$114,318.31 - \$117,747.86 per annum for scheduled work hours.

SECTION 2. That the salary of Police Lieutenant of the Village of Terrace Park shall range from \$104,354.98 – \$107,485.63 per annum for scheduled work hours.

SECTION 3. That the salary of Police Sergeant of the Village of Terrace Park shall range from \$96,490.98 - \$98,364.59 per annum for scheduled work hours.

SECTION 4. That the salary of Patrol Officers shall range from \$92,234.77 - \$95,001.81 per annum for scheduled work hours.

SECTION 5. That the salary of maintenance personnel shall range from \$31.15 – \$34.03 per hour for laborers and \$36.40 – \$39.76 per hour for maintenance foreman.

SECTION 6. That the salaries shall be payable in equal semi-monthly installments. Scheduled work hours per annum shall be 2,080 work hours. All hours worked in excess of the scheduled work hours may be returned to the employee in compensated time off at the rate of one and a half per each hour worked or pay at one and a half times the hourly rate if approved by the Chief of Police in the case of full-time Police Officers, full-time Maintenance Workers and Probationary Officer. Approval of pay in lieu of compensated time off for additional work in excess of scheduled work hours shall be totally within the discretion of the approving authority.

Determination of overtime pay due for hours worked in excess of scheduled work hours may awarded or paid on the next regular pay period as the approving authority deems most appropriate, as adjusted for compensation time which may be exercised in accordance to policy.

SECTION 7. That the salary of part-time patrol officers of the Village of Terrace Park shall be determined by experience.

SECTION 8. That the salary for the Administrative Assistant / Village Clerk shall range from \$18.79 - \$20.52 per hour.

SECTION 9. That the salary for Mayor's Court Clerk shall range from \$26.75 - \$29.78 per hour.

SECTION 10. That the salary for the Chief Fiscal Officer shall range from \$27.26 - \$29.78 per hour.

SECTION 11. That the annual salary for Village Administrator shall range from \$24,620.92 - \$25,359.54

SECTION 12. That future employee across the board pay raises, commencing March 16, 2026, through March 15, 2028, must be approved by council and will not exceed, during the aforementioned dates, an annual increase of 3%. Council has the discretion to review individual salaries and adjust compensation accordingly at any time.

SECTION 13. That the foregoing salary schedule shall become effective March 16, 2026. All Ordinances, Resolutions, and regulations, heretofore passed and adopted providing for such salaries, and/or wages are hereby repealed on that date.


SECTION 14. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is authorized and directed to publish this Resolution in the Village as heretofore determined by Council.



RESOLUTION 3-2, 2026

**REQUESTING THE HAMILTON COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE
CALCULATION OF REVENUE GENERATED BY THE RENEWAL OF THE
VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK EXISTING 5.58 MILL CURRENT
OPERATING LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mills limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Terrace Park, Hamilton County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village currently levies a tax of 5.58 mills approved by the electors of the Village of Terrace Park for current operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that in order to continue to provide adequate governmental services for the Village that it is necessary to renew the existing 5.58 mill levy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF TERRACE PARK, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO that:**

Section 1. The Council of the Village of Terrace Park hereby determines that it is necessary to renew the current operating levy of 5.58 mills at a rate not to exceed 5.58 mills for each \$1.00 of taxable value, pursuant to section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, which amounts to \$0.558 for each \$100.00 of the county auditor's appraised value, for five (5) years.

Section 2. Said renewal levy shall be placed upon the tax list of 2026 for collection in 2026 if the majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. The renewal tax levy for general operating purposes shall be submitted to the electors of Terrace Park at a regular election to be held at the usual voting places within Terrace Park on November 3, 2026.

Section 4. The entire territory of the Village of Terrace Park exists only within Hamilton County, and the proposed tax shall be submitted to and levied upon the entire territory of the Village of Terrace Park.

Section 5. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to immediately certify to the County Auditor this Resolution requesting that the County Auditor certify to the Council of the Village of Terrace Park the total tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount or revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid 5.58 mills.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be adopted as an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare within the community for the reason that it is necessary to continue to provide the necessary governmental services for the citizens of the Village of Terrace Park.






